# Photos say more than 1000 words: Using Photovoice method to increase youth participation

- General info: How to reach decision makers to improve the conditions on the local level? How to involve youth in social change? In the Erasmus+ project "Upraise Youth participation through Social Change" partners from DE, GR, RO and CY explored methods of non-formal learning to increase active participation of young people to become change makers in their local community. Participants will get an overview of the practice orientated results of the project, starting with a taster session of Kahoot Quizzes. Then participants will get a very practical insight on one of the methods, namely PhotoVoice. PhotoVoice is a participatory action research method that employs photography and group dialogue as a means for marginalized individuals to deepen their understanding of a community issue or concern. The visual images and accompanying stories are the tools used to reach policy- and decision-makers. The aim of this research method is to improve conditions by making changes at the community level. Perdita will not only give advice on how to set up a PhotoVoice Project and implement it, she will also give some advice on how to take a good picture so that one photo can say more than 1000 words!

Perdita Wingerter is the CEO and founder of the NGOS "Gemeinsam leben & lernen in Europa" (Living and learning together within Europe), has her own consulting agency and works also as a trainer. Being an active volunteer for over 30 years now, she is also promoting volunteering in various ways: Within her organisation "Gemeinsam leben & lernen in Europa" she initiated and coordinated many volunteer led projects on national and international level, especially ones involving young volunteers. By providing trainings, coaching and opportunities she has empowered hundreds of people to become not only volunteers but also active citizens. In the past years many of the volunteer projects she initiated empowered youth, migrants, refugees, people with disabilities and other disadvantaged groups of society. The organisation has won many awards for its work, e.g. the "Citizens prize" of the European Parliament or the "Active Citizens of Europe Award".
